

Morganelli picks up key endorsement

As you may know, this is Northampton County DA John Morganelli, pictured with his newest supporter.

A pro-life, pro-gun "D", Morganelli's traveling the state to drum up support for his bid to unseat State Attorney General <u>Tom Corbett</u>, who's up for re-election this fall.

Yesterday, as <u>reported</u> by the Philadelphia Inquirer, Morganelli and Rocky were in Montgomery County to condemn the decision to move the <u>Barnes Foundation</u> to the Benjamin Franklin Parkway, which could take a Balboa-like effort. Earlier this year a MontCo judge <u>blocked</u> the foundation's request to keep the collection in Lower Merion, despite Albert Barnes' <u>last wishes</u>.

Morganelli's facing his own Apollo Creed in Corbett. The incumbent has nearly doubled his fundraising, and recent headline-grabbing <u>indictments</u> haven't helped. Not to mention, MCall <u>Capitol Ideas</u> man John Micek calls the row office a "virtual Republican fiefdom."

According to campaign filings, as of May 22, Morganelli had \$618,817.02 on hand, while Corbett has amassed \$1,122,568.02. He also owns <u>attorneygeneral.gov</u>, which pretty much seals the deal.
